POLITICAL SIGN REMINDER

Sixty (60) days before an election, political signs may be displayed only in the inside, upper part of the two (2) front windows on the main level of each unit. No lights of any sort are permitted to draw attention to the sign. Political signs must be removed within one (1) day of the election. No political sign may be displayed in any common area, on fences, or in carports.

- 5) No children under 14 shall be in the pool area without a supervising adult accompanying them.
- 6) No alcoholic beverages are permitted inside the pool area.
- 7) No profanity may be used inside the pool area.
- 8) No animals are allowed inside the pool area.
- 9) No smoking inside the pool area.

Drinks are allowed, but not on the apron of the pool, defined as the concrete ring at the edge of the pool. Please keep drinks at the table. If you choose to play music, please use headphones.
